Summer Programs

Our summer programming provides full-day, full-week camps for rising K-8 grade students from 9am - 4pm. Each camp explores different areas of STEAM through hands-on, project based learning in a fun and accessible way.

Days Off Workshops

This dynamic full-day workshop series introduces K-5 and 9-12 grade students to a wide range of skills, knowledge, industries, and realworld fun on scheduled school outage days when caretakers still have to work.

Link.ed School Residencies

 Our Link.ed School Residency Program is designed to introduce and deepen students' understanding and confidence in a wide range of STEAM subjects through after-school programming.

Apprenticeships in STEAM Exploration

Our Apprenticeships in STEAM Exploration (ASE) program connects motivated high school students with mentors in science, technology, engineering, the arts and math (STEAM) pre-professional internships. The driving value behind the ASE program is that the interns should contribute to and learn from the mentor's work.

Saturday Academy partners with corporations and area businesses to ensure access to immersive hands-on learning experiences for all students K-12 grade in Oregon and SW Washington.

We curate transformative experiences through student-centered learning opportunities that explore the intersections of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM), designed to remove barriers of access to necessary transformation.

We believe that through these explorations students will cultivate a deeper sense of their identity, community connection, and global awareness fostering informed innovators for the next generation.


